Bronze Competition Organizers: Sale of Bronze Sport Licenses at Competitions



Organizers of Equine Canada sanctioned competitions at the Bronze level, or containing Bronze divisions have the opportunity to sell 2011 Bronze Equine Canada at their competition(s) to individuals who cannot provide proof of current and valid Equine Canada Sport License. Initiated as a pilot project in 2010, the Bronze Sport License Kit program is being offered again in 2011, with changes made to improve ease of use for organizers and competitors. Important changes to this program for 2011 include:

1. Competition organizers are not required to sell Bronze Sport Licenses at their competition. However, the Bronze Sport License Kit replaces Temporary Sport Licenses at Bronze competitions, and Bronze competitions **may not sell Temporary Sport Licenses to their participants**. A competition organizer who chooses not to sell Bronze Sport Licenses at their competition may not accept entries from prospective competitors who cannot provide proof of current and valid EC Sport License, OR must provide a computer with internet access to permit the competitor to purchase/renew their EC Sport License at www.equinecanada.ca.
2. The Bronze Sport License Kit application form now includes a tear-off bottom portion, removing the requirement to complete the Bronze Sport License Kit proof of purchase card.
3. Competition organizers will no longer receive an invoice for the value of the Bronze Sport License kit. However, all Bronze Sport Licenses sold must be submitted to Equine Canada with payment, attached to the Competition Master Report Form.
4. Bronze Sport License Kits will not be automatically shipped to Bronze competitions; instead they will be available on request on the Competition Application Form (see page 1), from the Equine Canada competitions department, or available for download at <http://eccompetitions.equinecanada.ca>
