



2011 Equine Canada/ NBEA Recreation and Industry Grant

Invitation to Apply

Thirty percent of the Equine Canada membership fees submitted by the NBEA is returned in the form of a Recreation and Industry grant. The purpose of this funding is to provide financial assistance for projects and programs designed to benefit recreational riders or the horse industry as a whole.

Who can apply?

- NBEA member clubs that are in good standing with the association.
- Individual NBEA members in good standing with the association.

**Grant money will only be awarded following completion of the project or program.*

**Funding is limited and may be divided among any number of applicants.*

What projects or programs are eligible?

- Equestrian trail or trailhead construction, upgrade, improvements or rehabilitation. ie. Signage, picnic sites, parking /camping/ toilet facilities, bridges, corrals etc.
- upgrades, rehabilitation or improvements to equine facilities and grounds.
- Educational seminars or clinics related to environmental issues, safety, or horse welfare.
- Other projects or programs deemed suitable.

***Projects must be situated on publicly owned or contracted land **or** club owned land.*

***Educational programs must be made available free of charge or for a nominal fee to anyone wishing to attend. Clinics must be open to all NBEA members.*
